### First Reading – 2 Samuel 7: 1-14a

<sup>1</sup> After the king was settled in his palace and the LORD had given him rest from all his enemies around him, <sup>2</sup>he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent." <sup>3</sup> Nathan replied to the king, "Whatever you have in mind, go ahead and do it, for the LORD is with you." <sup>4</sup> But that night the word of the LORD came to Nathan, saying: 5 "Go and tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD says: Are you the one to build me a house to dwell in? <sup>6</sup>I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt to this day. I have been moving from place to place with a tent as my dwelling. Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their rulers whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?" 8 "Now then, tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD Almighty says: I took you from the pasture, from tending the flock, and appointed you ruler over my people Israel. <sup>9</sup>I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have cut off all your enemies from before you. Now I will make your name great, like the names of the greatest men on earth. 10 And I will provide a place for my people Israel and will plant them so that they can have a home of their own and no longer be disturbed. Wicked people will not oppress them anymore, as they did at the beginning <sup>11</sup> and have done ever since the time I appointed leaders over my people Israel. I will also give you rest from all your enemies. "'The LORD declares to you that the LORD himself will establish a house for you: 12 When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. <sup>13</sup> He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. <sup>14a</sup>I will be his father, and he will be my son.

20 I have found David my servant; with my sacred oil I have anointed him.

- 21 My hand will sustain him; surely my arm will strengthen him.
- 22 The enemy will not get the better of him; the wicked will not oppress him.
- 23 I will crush his foes before him and strike down his adversaries.
- 24 My faithful love will be with him, and through my name his horn will be exalted.
- 25 I will set his hand over the sea, his right hand over the rivers.

26 He will call out to me, 'You are my Father, my God, the Rock my Saviour.'

- 27 And I will appoint him to be my firstborn, the most exalted of the kings of the earth.
- 28 I will maintain my love to him forever, and my covenant with him will never fail.
- 29 I will establish his line forever, his throne as long as the heavens endure.
- 30 "If his sons forsake my law and do not follow my statutes,
- 31 if they violate my decrees and fail to keep my commands,
- 32 I will punish their sin with the rod, their iniquity with flogging;
- 33 but I will not take my love from him, nor will I ever betray my faithfulness.
- 34 I will not violate my covenant or alter what my lips have uttered.
- 35 Once for all, I have sworn by my holiness—and I will not lie to David—
- 36 that his line will continue forever and his throne endure before me like the sun;
- 37 it will be established forever like the moon, the faithful witness in the sky."

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now and shall be forever. Amen.
